# **Work Requirements 2023**

| Award Type  | Hours Required   | Cleanups  |

| <b>Year-end Highpoint</b> for riders                          | 2 hours per show attended  | <b>Recommended but not required</b>                   |
| <b>Bronze Work Award</b> for members who volunteer 1-4 hours  | All members who work 1-4 hours and RSVP to the banquet will receive a coupon for free raffle tickets or free horse show class.                   | <b>Count toward work awards but are not required.</b> |
| <b>Silver Work Award</b> for members who volunteer 5-21 hours | All members who work 5-21 hours and RSVP to the banquet will receive a hat or other equal-value award.   | <b>Count toward work awards but are not required.</b> |
| <b>Gold Work Award</b> for members who work 22 hours or more  | All members that work 22 or more cumulative horse show, jackpot, show prep or cleanup hours will receive a sweatshirt or other equal-value award | <b>Count toward work awards but are not required.</b> |
| <b>Board Award</b> for board members                          | The majority of board meetings must be attended. The executive or horse show tasks assigned must be completed and count for this award.          | <b>Recommended but not required</b>                   |

### Year-End Highpoint Award

Regardless of your membership type, all riders that would like to receive year-end highpoint or honorable mention need to work two hours at each show they ride in. All children age 10 and older must also complete two work hours at each show they ride at to get their points.

### Cleanups

Cleanups are not required for any year-end awards but as always it is very helpful to come to meetings to share your ideas and to help clean up your club! Cleanup hours can be recorded and do count toward work awards.

### Recording Hours for Highpoint and Work Awards

To log your hours, enter them on the google form that the Secretary has created and will send out before each show. Write in your name, the areas you worked, your start and stop times, and the total number of hours. If you are unable to log your hours the day of the show, you must enter them within a week of the show. If you do not work a show, you will not receive your points for that show toward year-end highpoint. If you have a medical or work emergency that forces you to leave a show before completing your hours, you must contact the Secretary within a week after the show with this information. You will need to make up your 2 work hours at the next show for a total of 4 hours worked at the next show. If there isn't another show, you will not receive your points. If you are unable to log your hours on the google sheet on your own, contact the Secretary within a week of the show and she will enter them for you. No hours can be logged after one week from the show except if medical or other emergencies prevented you from logging your hours. If you do not log your hours within one week of the event, it will result in a forfeit of your year-end points and work hours for that show.
